Learn Russian in the European Union, established in 2004, is a joint initiative of the Department of Russian and Slavic Linguistics at Daugavpils University and Training Center LatInSoft.

Learn Russian in the EU has provided numerous academic study abroad, summer, and custom-designed programs to US universities, federal service academies, government institutions, and individual graduate and undergraduate students.

Our programs are hosted at Daugavpils University. They include the Russian language at levels up to ACTFL Superior, as well as academic courses in literature, culture, political science, history, East European studies, and STEM, provided in Russian.

Daugavpils, the second largest city in Latvia, is a Russian-language enclave, where almost everybody uses modern standard Russian for daily communication. Daugavpils is the largest Russian-speaking city in the European Union and NATO.

International students undergo full linguistic immersion and amazing cultural experience in a city that was once part of both the Russian Empire and the Soviet Union, and which has a remarkable historical legacy tied to Russia and Russian-European relations. The people, nature, and climate are just like in the Central Russia. This helps understand the culture, traditions, and lifestyle.
